OHIO LIFE SCIENCES ADVOCACY EVENTS

February - Grassroots Lobbying Day

OLS is convening board members and key organizations for a day of meetings with Legislators in support of the Ohio Life Sciences earmark in the operating budget. The day will include meetings with House and Senate members and a lunch briefing on our budget request for all Legislators and staff.

Previously, OLS secured funding to build out workforce development initiatives and to establish the Ohio Life Sciences Industry Hub and Training Center in the Columbus Innovation District. This year, we're requesting a modest budget increase to expand critical infrastructure and drive industry growth.

April - Breakfast Roundtable on the Patient Value Chain

OLS will host a roundtable featuring industry experts to educate Legislators and staff on the patient value chain, covering the entire process of developing, manufacturing, distributing, and delivering products or treatments to patients. The goal of this session is to better inform our lawmakers of the critical role Ohio companies play in developing and delivering life-changing and life-saving treatments to their constituents. After a day filled with meetings, OLS members gather in the Statehouse for further, more intimate discussions with elected leaders and their staff over drinks and appetizers. This setting allows for more natural conversations and for our elected officials to meet dozens of industry professionals from every corner of the state.
